TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY FAQ

What is TBI?

TBI is the result of a sudden, violent blow or jolt to the head. Brain injuries vary depending on the part of the brain affected and the extent of the damage. Not all blows or jolts to the head result in a traumatic brain injury. Correctly diagnosing TBI is of prime importance in regard to getting the treatment you need when you need it.

What causes TBI?

The causes of traumatic brain injury are: falls; cars, bicycles, and motorcycle accidents; being struck by an object such as a hockey puck or baseball bat or being struck against something such as a roller coaster ride; or being assaulted. Infants who suffer from shaken baby syndrome and difficult birth deliveries may also suffer from TBI.

What are the symptoms of TBI?

Persistent headache, repeated vomiting or nausea, convulsions or seizures, inability to awaken from sleep, slurred speech, numbness, loss of coordination, pupil dilation, increased agitation

WHAT'S IT LIKE TO LIVE WITH TBI?

Living with a traumatic brain injury greatly impacts the injured victim and puts a huge strain on families and caregivers. The victim will feel helpless and depressed. Medical bills become a constant albatross. Every day is a challenge. Mostly, families are busy coping with the daily grind that they forget about seeking legal help.

Are there time constraints for filing a traumatic brain injury suit?

Yes, individual states have laws called statutes of limitations which limit how much time victims can initiate legal action. Do not procrastinate.

What does the TBI settlement compensation cover?

The potential compensation can cover mounting medical bills resulting from screening, diagnosis, tests, treatments and rehabilitation. Compensation may also include illness, pain and suffering you have experienced as well as the mental anguish and grief suffered by you and your family. Compensation may include payment to caregivers and financial security for your family if the breadwinner has lost the ability to earn an income.
